EUBIA PROFILE

EUBIA is an international non-profit industry association located in Brussels, Belgium. It groups together market forces, technology providers, and knowledge centres, all of them active in the field of biomass. EUBIA's main objective is to support the European biomass industries at all levels, promoting the use and market uptake of biomass as an energy source, developing innovative bioenergy concepts and projects and fostering international co-operation within the bioenergy field. EUBIA has a strong record in the identification of business opportunities and specific bio-projects with an acceptable return of investment for private investors. The association is a full funding member of the steering committee of the G8-GB partnership and it is actively promoting refined solid biomass residues from the agricultural and forestry sectors. In addition EUBIA is working on the identification of new advanced technology for a more efficient agricultural residues valorisation supply chain strategies and new efficient technologies with attractive trading perspectives on both the small and large scale level. EUBIA EXPERIENCES IN BIOMASS NEW ADVANCED TECHNOLOGIES



According to the cooperation with investors and industries who are members of the association, EUBIA is often involved in commercial projects as technical consultant on a wide range of new activities, both in Europe and worldwide.

Feasibility studies, research activity cooperation and new consortium has been provided by EUBIA during these years.

Due to the high experience of EUBIA Secretary General and the large technical projects provided, the association matured a strong know how in the following sectors:

- Solid biomass refining (pelletization, torrefaction, etc..).
- Logistics for large scale supply of refined biomass.
- Solid biomass combustion technologies. (Fluidized Bed Combustion, Chemical Looping, Co-firing).
- Thermochemical processes for biomass residues valorization (HTC, Intermediate pyrolysis, Torrefaction, Gasification, Flash pyrolysis).
- Liquid biofuel for transportation (sweet sorghum and sugar cane ethanol, biodiesel from microalgae, Used Cooking Oil and vegetable oil, MicroWaves transterification, syngas FT reaction).
- Biomass cultivation sustainability and efficient supply chain strategies. (compactation machineries, biofertilizers, biochar application).
- Micro and macro algae. (Market assessment, business plan, sustainability assessment).

EUBIA ACTIVITY WITH RESEARCH INSTITUTES AND UNIVERSITIES



EUBIA is promoting a new initiative, named EUBREN (European Blomass Research Network). It consists in a selection of Universities and Research centers in all the European countries. The objective is to promote biomass research activity in EU, involving universities and research centres to discuss and cooperate for new projects development.

The final target is to enhance the cooperation between universities and SMEs, in order to launch not only new EC projects, but also new independent initiatives to accelerate the deployment of innovative technologies and activities.

The European Commission last funding programmes demonstrate how the institution is pushing to foster new projects and initiatives where industries merge their efforts with research centres and universities.

Currently, more than 20 universities from 18 EC countries sent their application to join EUBREN. Thanks to the interest of so many institutes, EUBIA is going to launch EUBREN in October 2014. All EUBIA members will be invited to participate to this network, as the involvement of industries and enterprises is crucial for securing the high level of the Network

EC PROJECT PROPOSALS INVOLVEMENT

EUBIA works involving its members in new EC project proposals (H2020, Life+, Interreg). At present, the association is working and writing new proposals where mainly association members are partners, to be submitted in 2015.

EUBIA will contact its members to participate in new project proposals. The involvement of members in European projects' consortium will be secured according to their experiences and past activities in the different biomass sectors. This activity is expected to grow quickly thanks to the European Biomass Research Network, The definition of new industry-universities project proposals will be one of the main targets of the Network

EU BIOMASS INDUSTRY SECTOR UPDATE



EUBIA policy and communication staff works close to the EC institutions in order to be constantly updated on the latest communications, publications and proposals discussed by policy makers regarding biobased sector in EU. In particular:

EUBIA analyses the EU policy framework in terms of products standardization, legal barriers, sustainability, market incentives and new directives with a relevant impact on the related biobased sectors.

These news are always integrated with an updated overview on market state of the art, facts and figures and future opportunities.

All these information are collected in detailed reports, sent to EUBIA members at least every two months.
