



















USED COOKING OIL TO BIODIESEL CHAIN

Used cooking oil is a problematic waste to get rid of. Its inadequate disposal can result in harmfull effects: it hinders sewage treatment, pollutes aquatic systems, blocks pipes and causes odors. One interesting option for UCO management is its energy valorization. Nevertheless, the lack of awareness and information among citizens and the technical and legislative barriers for UCO collection lead consumers to pour it directly to the sink.
