EUBIA, the European Biomass Industry Association focuses its activities on large-scale bioenergy systems and technologies appropriate for rural development in semi-industrialised and developing countries.

EUBIA promotes a World Network on Bioenergy. The purpose of this Network is to address worldwide the adequate utilisation of biomass residues and energy crops and to arrive at local, regional, national and international solutions for bioenergy applications.

The Network Comprises 48 partners from 24 countries worldwide. The network partners represent bioenergy research, development, industry and bioenergy promotion from around the globe.

The World Network on Bioenergy succeeded to:

- Set up a trans-national forum for the promotion of the sustainable use of biomass and bioenergy in Latin America, Europe, China and Africa.
- Identify efficient, cost competitive and reliable technologies.
- Ensure cost-effectiveness, simplicity in maintenance, social acceptance and a positive impact on the environment.
- Promote small-scale, decentralised bioenergy technology applications.
- Identify international co-operation opportunities
- Support the elaboration of suitable policies for the promotion of biomass and bio-energy worldwide.

In particular, the World Network on Bioenergy succeeded in initiating the development of modern bioenergy complexes for remote rural villages based on the exploitation of agroforestry residues or dedicated biomass crops. **EUBIA's motto: We promote Bioenergy, humankind's renewable energy resources for a sustainable future.**
